Admad Radzi Badruddin is currently CEO and Consultant Clinical Oncologist at the Integrated Oncology Centre in Johor Bahru, Malaysia. He also holds the positions of Sessional Consultant Clinical Oncologist at Hospital Pantai Kuala Lumpur; Visiting Consultant Clinical Oncologist at Sunway Medical Centre, Selangor and Gleneagles MC, Medini, Johor Bahru, Malaysia.

Dr Ahmad Radzi graduation from the National University of Malaysia (UKM) in 1984 and went on to obtain a Diploma in Medical Radiotherapy (DMRT) from the Royal College of Radiologist and an FFRCS from Dublin. He was a visiting fellow in stereotactic radiosurgery and gamma knife in the Department of Therapeutic Radiology and Gamma Knife Center at the Singapore General Hospital, Singapore, as well as visiting fellow to Beatson Oncology Centre, Western Infirmary Hospital, Glasgow, Scotland.

He had been a panel member of several consensus meetings organized by the Ministry of Health Malaysia, including the Breast Cancer Consensus Meeting. In 2016, he served as Chairman of the Scientific Programme Committee of the Annual Scientific Congress of the Malaysian Oncological Society.
