Dr Lingeswaran Kasilingam is a Consultant Nuclear Medicine Physician at Beacon International Specialist Centre (BISC), Petaling Jaya, Malaysia. He graduated in Medicine in 2006 followed by Masters in Nuclear Medicine in 2013 from Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM). He joined briefly as a teaching faculty in Nuclear Medicine at USM from 2013 to 2018. He obtained clinical fellowship training in radionuclide therapy from Peter MacCallum Cancer Institute, Melbourne, Australia in 2016. He successfully performed the first Lutetium-177 PSMA therapy in metastatic castrate resistant prostate carcinoma (mCRPC) in South and Far East Asia in June 2017 at BISC. He has treated more than 100 patients with Neuroendocrine Tumour (NET) and mCRPC with more than 300 cycles of Lutetium-177 treatment carried out so far at BISC. His patients come from as far as Korea, Pakistan, Indonesia, Singapore, Myanmar, Taiwan and USA. He has delivered lectures in numerous local and overseas scientific forums. He is currently serving as President of Malaysian Society of Nuclear Medicine and Molecular Imaging (MSNMMI) and Vice-President (Nuclear Medicine), College of Radiology (CoR), Academy of Medicine, Malaysia.
