She was a member of ASTRO International Educational Subcommittee (IES) and of the International Advisory Board of the International Journal of Radiation Oncology, Biology and Physics (IJROB). She is the Vice President and the former head of the Education and Training committee of the Federation of Asian Organizations in Radiation Oncology (FARO).

She has been involved in research activities (locally and internationally) and inspired and co-authored research papers with her residents and colleagues which have been acclaimed locally and internationally.
